

Dear Friends and Supporters of Living University,

Our faculty, staff and students send you their warm greetings on this gorgeous summer day in Charlotte. Excitement is in the air as we begin our tenth year of operation. Our online students are excited and ready to learn and our headquarters office in Charlotte is busy with 13 full-time students in the buildings. Our on-campus LU classes began this morning, and as of today we have 167 students enrolled for credit and 72 registered to audit classes, for a total of 239 students for the fall semester. This year we have seventeen students in residence—13 in Charlotte and 4 in Clarendon, South Australia. Additionally, we have over twenty students from Africa taking classes this semester. Enrollment *for credit* increased 37% over fall semester 2015. Overall enrollment increased 29% over last fall which is a new record enrollment for LU.

On August 24 we plan to dedicate Sheryl Manor, our new women's residence, in memory of Mrs. Sheryl Meredith. The dedicatory plaque shown below will appear at the front entry of the home and is visible to all who enter.



Following the dedication, Sheryl Manor will then serve as the venue of the annual Faculty Reception welcoming our new Charlotte on-campus students. At this time I would like to introduce all our students in-residence in both Charlotte, North Carolina and Clarendon, South Australia. As you will see, they have diverse backgrounds and come from many different areas. God's Work is blessed to have these young people working and learning in our offices in Charlotte and Clarendon.
