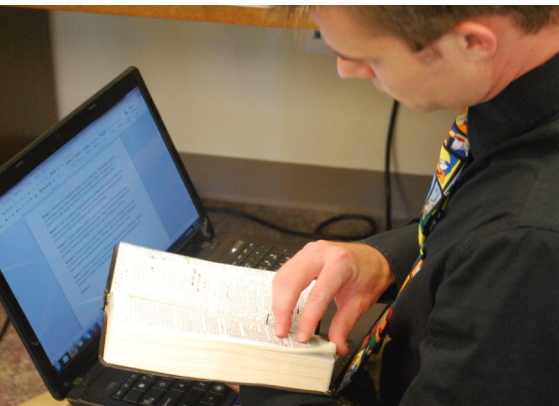

Admission

Individuals seeking to complete a Certificate, Diploma or Degree must file an online *Application for Admission*. Those who seek only to enroll in one or more single courses, but who do not desire to pursue a certificate, may do so through the Open Learning Program. Admission to an online certificate program does not necessitate an applicant having a high school diploma or the equivalent, but admission to a diploma or degree program does. All programs, however, require fluency in reading and writing standard English.

Registration

Students complete registration and orientation online. For exact dates of the Early Registration and Registration periods see the Academic Calendar in the University Catalog or on the LU website (www.livinguniv.com).

Advisement

Upon entering a certificate, diploma or degree program a student is assigned an adviser who will be available for program advisement and career information. An adviser helps a student create a workable plan to meet his or her educational objectives within a reasonable time period.

Tuition, Fees, and Other Expenses

The tuition fee is \$115 per semester hour. The University seeks to assist qualified students affiliated with the Living Church of God in meeting educational expenses through its Regents Scholarship program. Visit the university online to determine if you meet the qualifications for such a scholarship. High school students, those in their 3rd year, and seniors aged 65 and above are all eligible for scholarships. There are several additional scholarship options listed in the online catalog.

Applicants to the University are required to submit an application fee with their credential program *Application for Admission*. No fee is required for an application for re-admission or reapplication within three years. All students are responsible for a \$35 technology fee for each semester of enrollment.
